-Have attained a cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.		
-Will be enrolling for the first time at a U.S. accredited college or university as a full time, degree-seeking student in the fall of 2011.		
-Have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extra-curricular or other activities.		
-Have completed and submitted all required materials by the deadline.

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

### If I live in Minneapolis, but do not attend a Minneapolis Public School, am I still eligible to apply?

No. If you do not currently attend a Minneapolis Public School, you are not eligible to apply.

#### What does the scholarship selection process look like and what is expected of my application?

The Camille A. Thomas Scholarship recipient(s) are chosen by a scholarship selection committee, not by Camille A. Thomas. The scholarship selection committee expects a completed application with much attention paid to the essay.

#### If I am already enrolled in post secondary courses, am I still eligible to apply (ex. PSEO, CIS, etc)?

Yes. High school students currently enrolled in post secondary courses are eligible to apply.

### If I do not plan to study a form of health education, am I still eligible to apply?

Yes. All graduates of Minneapolis Public High Schools are eligible to apply for the 2011 CATS.

### When is the application due? Will you accept late application materials?

All application materials must be postmarked by June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Late Applications will not be accepted.

### Will you accept a photocopy of my transcript?

No. Transcripts must be official and submitted in a sealed envelope from your school's registrar.

#### How many candidates are expected to apply?

We expect 30-50 applicants to apply for this year's scholarship.

#### If I am chosen to receive this scholarship, when will I be notified?

Scholarship recipient/s will be notified on or before July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

#### When will I actually receive the scholarship funds?

Half of the scholarship award will be sent directly to your college/university immediately upon receiving a copy of your Fall 2011 course schedule and other information. The second half of the scholarship award will be sent to your college/university upon receiving <u>proof of academic eligibility</u> (2.0 GPA or higher during your first semester).
